Mandatory –

- Grades Kindergarten through 7: Beauty - \$50.00 (includes one program)
- Grades 8 through 12: Beauty: \$75.00 (includes one program and a t-shirt)

Optional (not mandatory) –

- Photogenic - \$10.00, one headshot, additional headshots \$5 each.
- Sweetheart Competition – One overall winner in grades Kindergarten through 8th; One overall winner in grades 9th through 12th. All proceeds benefit the WKHS Athletics needs. Individual awards for meeting different levels will also be awarded – see additional information.
- Additional T-shirt – \$10.00
- Additional Program Book - \$10.00

Grades 9 – 12: Community Service Awards – to be awarded per grade and one overall winner.

Grades K – 8: Overall People’s Choice – one overall winner in grades K – 8.

Grades 9 – 12: Overall People’s Choice – one overall winner in grades 9 – 12.

Grades 9 – 12: Congeniality Award - to be voted on by your peers after rehearsal. One in each grade.

Grades K – 8: Overall Ad Sales Award – to be awarded to the contestant with the most ad sales.

Grades 9 – 12: Overall Ad Sales Award – to be awarded to the contestant with the most ad sales.

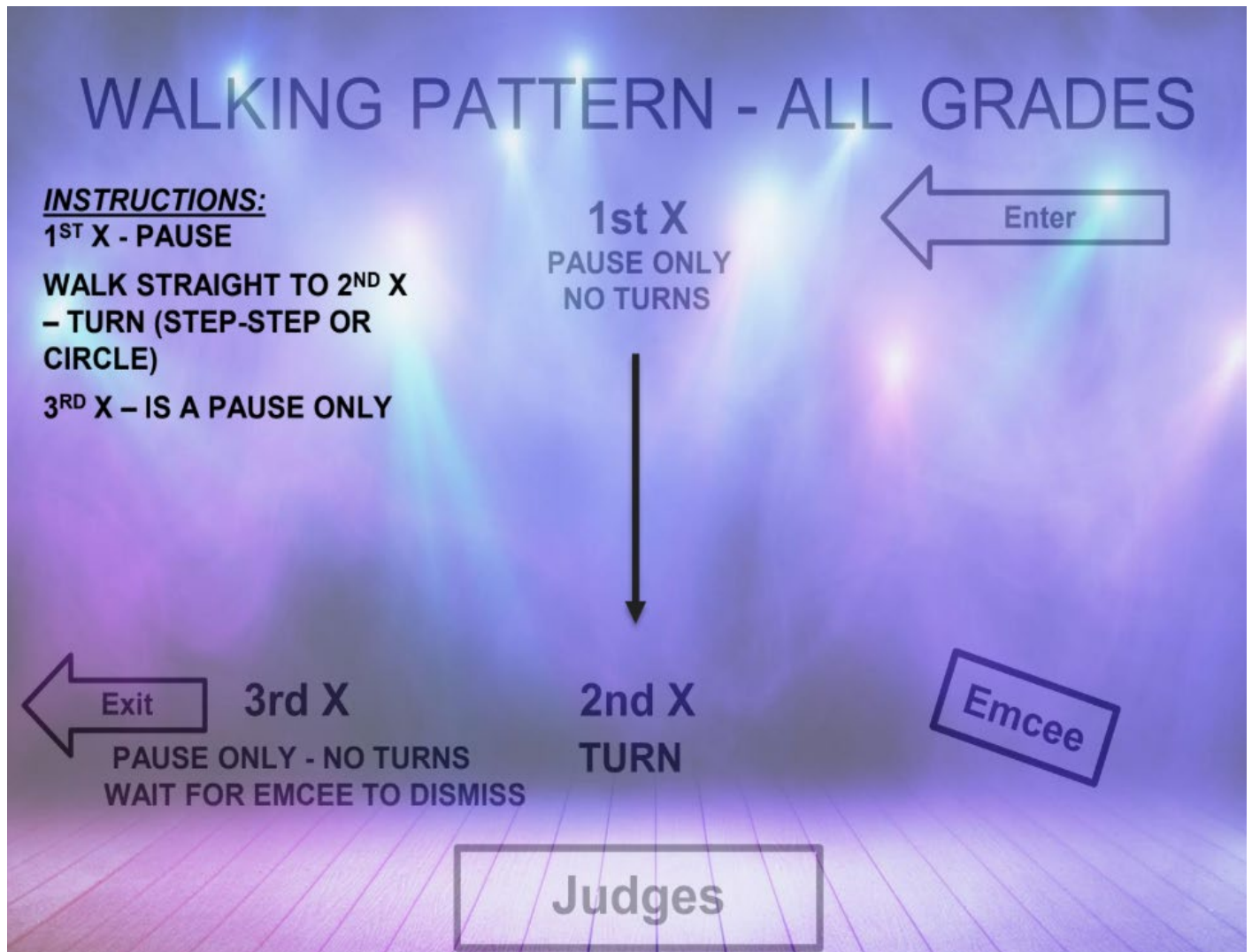
Beauty:

Grades Kindergarten through 5th may wear Sunday or pageant style dresses, short or long. Grades 6th through 12th must wear long evening gown dresses.

Dresses should fit appropriately. Dress should be age appropriate and be modest in appearance. Consider adding a modesty panel to a dress with a low V bodice. Consider tacking high splits to maintain modesty. Consider speaking with your dress store associate or seamstress if you have questions.

Contestants in grades K-7 will receive their contestant number at rehearsal. Contestants in grades 8 – 12 will receive their contestant number via email with interview times by January 31, 2026.

Walking Pattern: Facing stage, emcee is on right, contestants enter emcee side in the back middle to back middle stage (X-1), contestants walk straight ahead middle front stage (X-2) – turn, contestants walk to their right (X-3), contestants exit stage AFTER emcee has said, “Thank you, contestant #, name.” The contestant is exiting the opposite side of the emcee. There will be a volunteer on both sides of the stage always. Everyone will be helped at rehearsals.



Opening Number – Grades 6 – 12:

Contestants will receive a t-shirt to wear in opening number. Contestants are to wear long blue jeans that do not have holes or rips. Jeans may be decorated. T-shirts are not to be decorated. Shoes are to be white sneakers and may be decorated. T-shirts will be provided to contestants at rehearsal in February.

Contestants will practice together at rehearsals entering the stage. Contestants will introduce themselves on stage giving their name and a one sentence fun fact about themselves or anything appropriate. On stage introduction/opening number is not scored. There will be no dance routine.

Interview – Grades 8 through 12 – February 21, 2026:

Grades 8th through 12th will interview 3 minutes with a panel of 3 judges, panel style, the same day as the pageant. Contestants will receive interview times by January 31, 2026. Approximate interview times are 8:00 a.m. through 12:00 p.m. starting with grade 8 and continuing through grade 12. Contestants shall arrive and enter The Center for Public Health & Advance Medical Studies building on their own 5 minutes prior to their interview time. Late arrivals will receive a point deduction by each judge. Interviews will only be allowed in person on this date and at the time that will be designated to the contestant. Please do not schedule anything on this date. Dress for success. Interview attire should consist of a nice interview dress or jumpsuit with appropriate shoes.

Interview: 50%

Beauty: 50%

Interview plus Beauty = Placements and Winners.

Photogenic Option – Grades Kindergarten through 12:

- This is an optional competition. Photos should consist of a head/shoulders shot of the contestant. Only the contestant should be in the headshot. The photo may be amateur or professional. No AI photos are accepted. PHOTO MUST BE LABELED WITH FULL NAME AND GRADE. Photos will be delivered at rehearsals on the deadline date January 12 and 13 and placed in a labeled bin on the stage. Late photos will not be accepted. Each grade with at least one photogenic entry will have a photogenic winner announced.

Miss Timberwolf Sweetheart Competition – Grades K through 12:

Contestants have the option to raise funds for the White Knoll High School Athletic Booster Club and receive awards on stage! See included Sweetheart Log at the end of this packet. Each dollar is a vote! If a contestant receives \$20 from one person, that is equal to 20 votes. If a contestant receives \$1 from one person, that is 1 vote. The contestant with the highest in votes for the Sweetheart Competition will be crowned Miss Timberwolf Overall Sweetheart 2026!

Each Contestant who meets the minimum below will receive an award:

50 Votes (\$50) – Small tiara

100 Votes (\$100) – Medium tiara

150 Votes (\$150) – Large tiara

Miss Timberwolf Overall Sweetheart 2026 - Largest tiara, embroidered rhinestone sash, rhinestone crown pin, rhinestone scepter, and will be featured on the WKHS Athletic Booster Club Page! Deadline to submit Sweetheart Votes is January 31, 2026. Late participation will not be accepted.

People’s Choice – Grades K through 12:

Each contestant will decorate a jar that will represent the contestant and include the contestant’s full name and grade. Jars should not exceed a 20 oz. size. Photos on the jars are suggested. Jars are to be brought to rehearsal February 17 and 18, 2026 to be placed on the table in the lobby of the PAC.

A link for People’s Choice will be provided in the Miss Timberwolf Facebook Group for online votes closer to the date of the pageant. Contestants may wish to copy the link to share with family, friends, on social media, etc.

Community Service – Grades 9 through 12:

Combined in one PDF file the following: The contestant’s name and grade; An essay to include all community service work in year 2025; As many photos in the PDF file of the variety of community service work performed; Any recognitions of achievement related to community service work; Any recommendation letters for this award; Anything in addition that would make you stand out to receive the Leader of the Pack award.

The Leader of the Pack award will be awarded to the one contestant in grades 9th through 12th with the most outstanding community service submission. A community service winner will also be announced in each grade with participation, 9th through 12th.

GRADES KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8:

Monday, January 12, 2026

- 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. – Headshots for Program Book by Amanda Upton Photography. WKHS Performing Arts Center. Arrive as early as your schedule permits. Must arrive no later than 5:30 p.m. to start rehearsal on time.
- 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. – Mandatory rehearsal and informative meeting for grades K-8; Parents for grades K-5 are required to stay. Parents for grades 6-8 are not required to stay.
- Deadline to submit photos for the optional photogenic portion of the competition. Photos for photogenic will be placed in labeled bin on stage at this rehearsal. Photos must be labeled on the back with contestant's full name and grade.

Friday, January 30, 2026

- Deadline to submit ads and ad fees to Booster Club.

Tuesday, February 17, 2026

- 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. – Mandatory rehearsal. Bring the shoes you'll wear with your dress during the pageant. WKHS Performing Arts Center.
- Grade 8 will pick up opening number t-shirt.

Wednesday, February 18, 2026

- Arrive to practice anytime between 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. – Non-mandatory rehearsal. This date is set aside to allow contestants more time to practice the individual stage walk. Bring the shoes you'll wear with your dress during the pageant. WKHS Performing Arts Center.

Saturday, February 21, 2026 – Grades K - 8:

- Contestants will check in at 1:00 p.m., WKHS Performing Arts Center
- Every chaperone must be female. Each chaperone will receive a chaperone badge that must be worn visible at all times. Chaperone badges shall not be transferred to another individual.
- Spectators may enter the auditorium after 1:30 p.m.
- Competition starts 2:00 p.m.
- Grades Kindergarten through 2 - Chaperone has the option to remain with the contestant during competition. Important – Contestants are expected to walk on stage alone. Chaperones are not required to come backstage and may watch from the auditorium being sure to return to the back of the stage after awards are complete. This is each parent's choice. Only chaperones with the chaperone badge will be allowed to come backstage or to a dressing room.
- Contestants in grades 3 through 5 – Contestants will be escorted to the stage by volunteers. Parents may head to the auditorium to watch by 1:50 p.m. Chaperones will return to the dressing room immediately following awards or after photos of winners.
- Contestants 6 – 8 – Only contestants will have access to dressing rooms, backstage, etc. Contestants will arrive in t-shirt and jeans ready for opening number.

- Spectators may enter the auditorium after 5:30 p.m.
- Competition starts 6:00 p.m.

Contestants only are allowed in dressing rooms, backstage, etc. Contestants only will check in. Volunteers will be in lobby ready to assist contestants with their dress/belongings if needed. Contestants will arrive in t-shirt and jeans ready for opening number.
