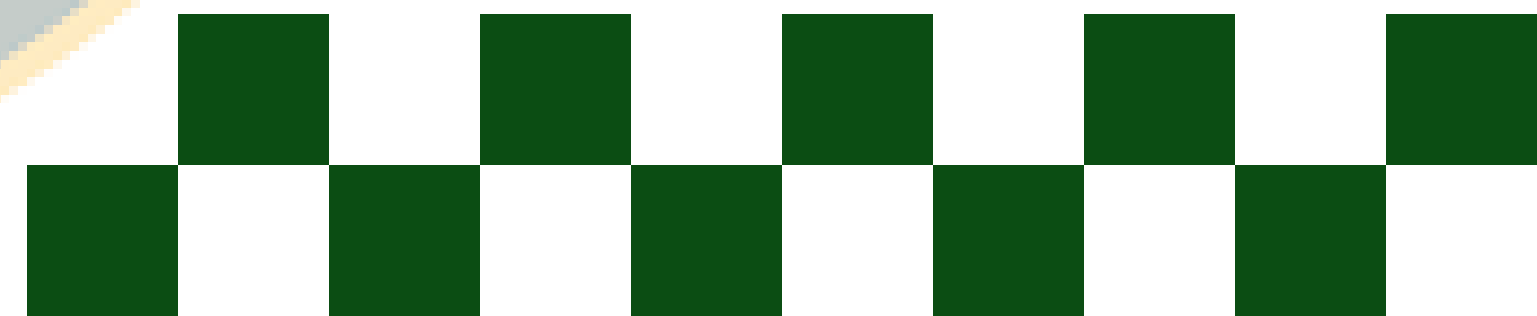

GAME DAY INFORMATION

Welcome to Spring Valley and the 2026 football season. I have enclosed Varsity and JV team schedules, and a map to the school with more detailed instructions. Please read in detail and pass on to your Band and Cheerleaders.

PARKING [JV & Varsity]

1. Football Team buses are allowed inside the stadium where a dressing room is available at the end of the stadium.
2. Football team buses enter at the traffic light close to the tennis courts on Sparkleberry Ln.
3. Drive around the back of the school building and enter the stadium on the Spring Valley side. Proceed down the hill, around the track, up the hill, and park in the spaces beside the visitor's concession stand. You may stop at the bottom of the hill to unload the buses.
4. Band buses and Cheerleader buses will be directed where to park by District 2 Security in The Stadium Parking Lot.
5. Band and Cheerleader buses are not allowed inside the stadium.

PRE-GAME [Varsity Only]

1. Pre-game warm-up area for visitors will be at the open end of the stadium. Spring Valley will use the hillside of the stadium.
2. Please use the area up to the fifty yard line.
3. Pre-game ceremonies will begin at 7:10. Please be off the field by this time. Game time is 7:30 p.m.

GAME DAY INFORMATION

PRESS BOX [JV & Varsity]

- *We ask that your football coaches and band cameramen use the designated visitor photo deck on the press-box side of the field.*
- *Please furnish your own field phones and use the designated visitor coaches' room in the press-box on the home side of the field.*

BAND INFORMATION [Varsity Only]

1. *Please have your band director communicate with our band director, Christopher Jenkins at (803) 699-3500 x69810.*
2. *All band members in uniform and band chaperones (two per bus) will be admitted free.*
3. *Visiting bands will not be allowed to use the field for any post-game performance.*
4. *The pre-game schedule will begin with twenty minutes showing on the clock, which should be approximately 7:10. This will allow ample time for the National Anthem and for other pre-game activities. The game will begin at 7:30.*

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION [JV & Varsity]

1. *Our team will wear green jerseys at all home games and white jerseys at all away games.*
2. *Halftime will last fifteen minutes for all games.*
3. *Please furnish your own towels.*
4. *We would appreciate your cleaning up your bench area after the game.*
5. *Please advise your players not to use the all-weather track as a path while they are wearing cleats. Protected crosswalks are provided.*
